Intimacy with God



Construction on our new office building is moving along. Last month, we received a short-term mission team from Joshua Expeditions. It was a group of 47 youth/leaders from Houston, TX. They helped us install safety fencing along the creek's edge, haul concrete block, mix concrete, and cut weeds along the creek-line with machetes.
